IKF Olympic Taskforce installed

The chosen candidates for the IKF Olympic Taskforce have been announced, following the IKF's Open Call to fill several positions in this newly created workgroup. Project manager of the task force is Jorge Rodrigues e Sousa. The task force members are Jens van Poucke, Ya-Wen Lin, Marjan de Jong, Williard "Bill" Johnson and Geert Hendriks. The Olympic Format task force is responsible to lead the project aimed at helping IKF to determine which of the new Korfball formats, with a smaller number of players compared to traditional Korfball8, has the largest chance of broad appeal among athletes, fans, National and Regional Federations and sponsors with the goal of appealing to the IOC for a possible inclusion on the Olympic program.
