Competitions

IKF World Beach Korfball Championship 2022

All National Federations have received the entry form for the IKF WBKC 2022, to be held in Nador, Morocco, from 19-20 August 2022.



IKF U21 European Korfball Championship

It has become clear that the proposed date for the IKF U21 EKC 2022 (the first weekend in June) is not feasible for many of

the European nations and the event is no longer viable in the current form. The IKF, together with the

KNKV, has taken the decision not to continue with these dates. The IKF would like to (re)invite potential hosts to send a note of interest to the office by 15 February, noting that the IKF's preferred date for a rescheduled event is September 2022.

IKF Europa Cup 2022

The IKF has taken the decision to look for an alternative date for the IKF Europa Cup 2022, after consultation with the participants and the Local Organising Committee. The event was originally scheduled to take place 10-12 February in the Netherlands, but due to the current

coronavirus developments in Europe and The Netherlands more specifically, it is currently not possible to carry out this event during the mentioned dates. The IKF, LOC and participants will look at alternative dates in the spring of 2022, and make a final decision about this event in the first week of February.

IKF Europe Korfball Champions League (KCL)

The IKF has decided to merge the IKF Europa Cup and IKF Europa Shield into the IKF Europe Korfball Champions League from the 2022/2023 season. The new format will allow for more matches between clubs of similar strength, doing justice to the growing club competitions in Europe. The KCL will consist of three successive qualification rounds, with stronger clubs entering in later phases of the competition, and three Final4 competitions: The Korfball Champions League Finals, The KCL Challenger Finals, and the KCL Satellite Finals.

The start of The World Games (TWG) 2022 is getting closer, we look forward to competing in Birmingham USA from 7 - 17 July. TWG also known as the 'Olympic Games for the non-Olympic Sports', has more than 31 different sports on the program. The

national teams of Belgium, China, Chinese Taipei, Czech Republic, Germany, the Netherlands, Portugal and Surinam will travel to the States to compete in the korfball competition, scheduled from 13 – 17 July. The World Games has published the Sports Competition Schedule, in which you can find the dates for all the sport competitions. It is safe to say that there is plenty to see! The IKF and the teams are now in full preparation for The World Games. IKF CEO Tilbert La Haye and IKF EXCO member Tilbert La Haye visited Birmingham in November last year for the second Competition Managers meeting. The countries have started their training programmes, like Team Surinam. Furthermore, the participants have received a newsletter about the World Games, which will be followed by an informative update meeting initiated by IKF in the first week of February.
