4 x 4 URBAN KORFBALL RULES	
Court and Ball	Circular playing field with 18 m diameter and with korf positioned in the centre that is divided into three areas: (1) 4 Seconds Area: 2.5 m radius, (2) 1 Point Area: 6 m radius, (3) 2 Point Area: 9 m radius
Team Roster	6 players: 2 men + 1 substitute and 2 women + 1 substitute
Referees	Up to 2
Jury	Up to 3: scorer, scoreboard operator, shot clock operator
Time-outs	N/A; two sets of five minutes, with one-minute half-time break
Initial Possession	Winner of toss chooses whether their team will start or not. Other team starts second set.
Scoring	1 point for shot within 1 Point Area (6 m); 2 points for shots outside 1 Point Area
Game Duration	5 minutes of real playing time during each of the two sets; If needed, third and last set is a series of 4 free shots from two male and two female players
Overtime	Golden goal period is 1 minute at the end of each set. If still no winner, penalty shots
Shot Clock	15 seconds
Penalty Shots	A penalty shot can be taken anywhere on the 2.5 m line
Attack to Defense Transition	Ball must be played outside the 6 m circle
Substitutions	Unlimited substitutions from substitution area
4 Seconds Area Time	No player can stay within the area longer than 4 seconds
No Coaches	Once the game has started, no coach intervention is allowed during the match
