

# URBAN KORFBALL RULES SUMMARY

4 X 4 URBAN KORFBALL RULES	
<b>COURT AND BALL</b>	Circular playing field with 18 m diameter and with korf positioned in the centre that is divided into three areas: (1) 4 Seconds Area: 2.5 m radius, (2) 1 Point Area: 6 m radius, (3) 2 Point Area: 9 m radius
<b>TEAM ROSTER</b>	6 players: 2 men + 1 substitute and 2 women + 1 substitute
<b>REFEREES</b>	Referee duo
<b>JURY</b>	Up to 3: jury chair, scoreboard operator, shot clock operator
<b>TIME OUTS</b>	N/A. Two sets of five minutes, with one-minute half-time break
<b>INITIAL POSSESSION</b>	Winner of toss chooses whether their team will start. Other team starts second set.
<b>SCORING</b>	1 point for shot within 1 Point Area (6 m). 2 points for shots outside 1 Point Area.
<b>GAME DURATION</b>	5 minutes during each of the two sets. If needed, third and last set is a series of 4 free shots from two male and two female players.
<b>OVERTIME</b>	Golden goal period is 2 minutes at the end of each set. If still no winner, penalty shots.
<b>SHOT CLOCK</b>	15 seconds
<b>PENALTY SHOTS</b>	Can be taken anywhere immediately behind the 2.5 m circle line
<b>ATTACK TO DEFENCE TRANSITION</b>	Ball must be played outside the 6 m circle
<b>SUBSTITUTIONS</b>	Unlimited substitutions from substitution area
<b>4 SECONDS AREA TIME</b>	No player can stay within the area longer than 4 seconds
<b>NO COACHES</b>	Once the game has started, no coach intervention is allowed during the match
